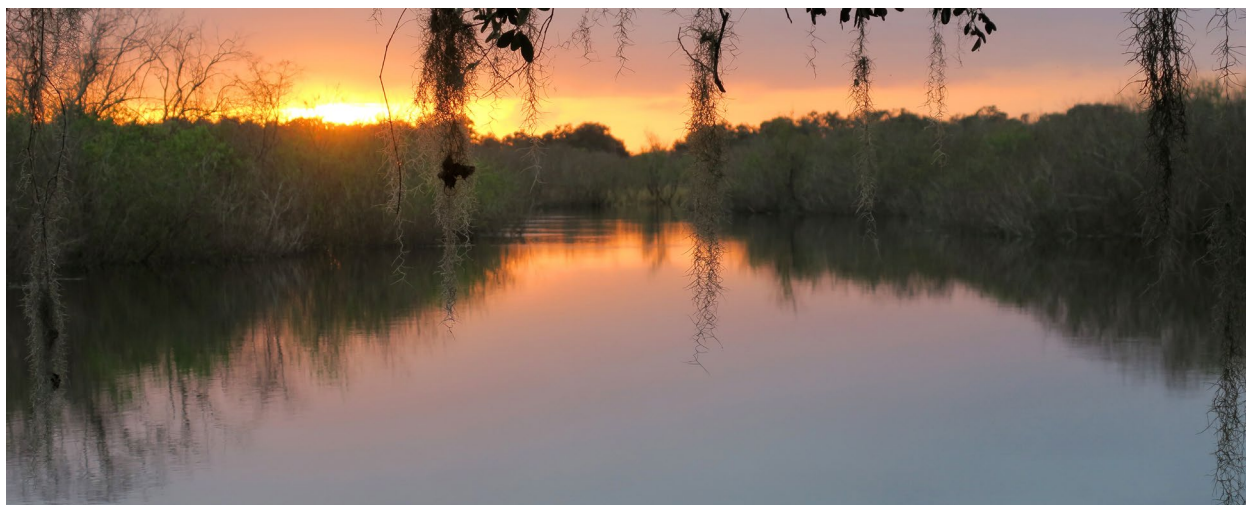




Kissimmee River Blueway

Now that a multi-year restoration effort of the Kissimmee River has been completed, this historic waterway is being discovered by paddlers. On June 25th, 2024, the Florida Greenways and Trails Council approved state designation of the Kissimmee River Blueway from the S-65 Lock at the bottom of Lake Kissimmee to C. Scott Driver Park just before Lake Okeechobee, a total of 76.5 miles. This waterway is considered part of the Everglades headwaters and was used historically by Seminole Native Americans. With a marshy floodplain up to two miles wide in places, it is a haven for bird life, alligators and other wildlife.

If paddling the entire blueway, you will pass through four locks. This process is easy and takes about 15 minutes each. There is no cost. Just before the lock, you pull on a cord to notify the lock keeper. Then, once directed into the lock, you hold onto a rope along either wall as the second gate slowly opens and water levels are lowered. Wait until the lock keeper instructs you to exit. Weekday Hours for all locks are Monday – Friday, all year, 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Weekend Hours for all locks are March 1 – October 31, 5:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m. November 1 – February 28, 5:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. The locks are labeled S-65, S-65A, S-65D, and S-65E. Locks S-65B and S-65C were removed as part of the restoration. For the beginning and latter part of the trip, you will be on the C-38 Canal.

Note: This is airboat country, so a tall flag on your canoe or kayak is recommended so you are visible over the marsh grass.

Campsites

Nine primitive campsites are situated along the river and are currently available for reservations on a first-come, first-served basis free of charge. More campsites

are available 1.3 miles west of the river along the Istokpoga Canal near the boat ramp. You must first follow the steps to obtain a [Special Use License](#) in order to make reservations. Each campsite is limited to 6 persons and leave no trace guidelines must be followed. The campsites have a picnic table and fire ring. In addition, you can make arrangements to stay at the Riverwoods Field Lab for a fee: 863-801-5145.

Water Levels

<https://w3.saj.usace.army.mil/h2o/reports/r-kss.html>. Ideal paddling is when water levels are below 1,400 cubic feet per second (cfs) at the S-65A gauge. The river begins to overflow its banks when above 1,400 cfs. Generally, the dry season is November through March.

44.4	L: Riverwoods Field Lab . Reservations and fee required: 863-801-5145	27.3838, -81.1107	On river right. Easy access. Vehicle access off US 98. Low ground. Secure boats if river is high.

52.2	PC: Chandler Slough Campsite	27.3565, -81.0339	Water access only. On river right.
